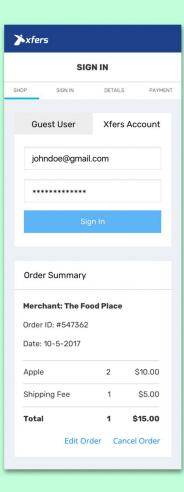


Checkout Flow Redesign

The checkout flow is part of the Xfers Redirect payment product. A redirect payments solution meant that buyers would place their orders on the merchants' website, and be redirected to Xfers checkout flow to complete the payment.

Note: This redesign project is in the pipeline and has not been launched yet.

Guest User

User Scenario: Mandy shops at Airpaz for the first time and needs a way to pay for her air tickets.

Behaviour: Mandy has never used Xfers before and is unfamiliar with paying online via bank transfer.

Goals & Needs: Wants the cheapest payment option.

Compares the prices of different payment methods.

Painpoint: Credit card payment is fast but there's additional fees for it.



Xfers Account User

User Scenario: Jay has been a regular shopper at Airpaz and needs a way to pay for his air tickets.

Behaviour: Jay uses Xfers to pay for his purchases on other sites as well. (e.g. Grouphunt / Airfrov / Dressabelle)

Goals & Needs: Wants a convenient way to pay via bank transfer.

Needs to store money in his wallet.

Painpoint: Having to do a manual bank transfer each time he buys something online is a hassle.

Gathering Requirements - Account Types



Guest User

Checkout: Login with phone number and verify OTP to create a guest account.

Account Balance: By default, there is no balance in a Guest wallet, hence top up needs to be done via Bank Transfer.

Payment Method: Besides bank transfer, guest user can pay via credit card if it is enabled for that transaction.



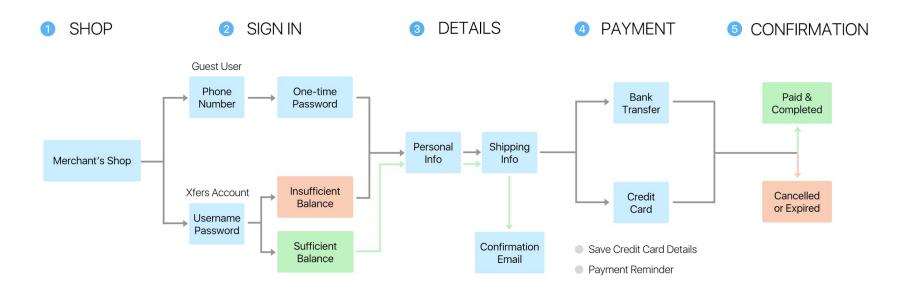
Xfers Account User

Checkout: Login with email address and password.

Account Balance: If there is sufficient balance in Xfers wallet, deduct money from the wallet to complete payment. Else, get user to top up Xfers account.

Payment Method: If Xfers account user does not want to top up his balance, he can choose to pay via credit card if it is enabled for that transaction.

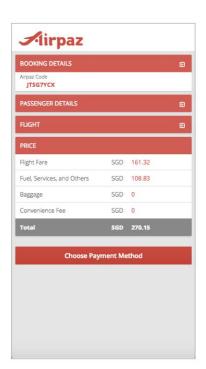
Checkout User Flow

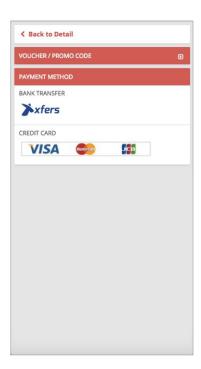


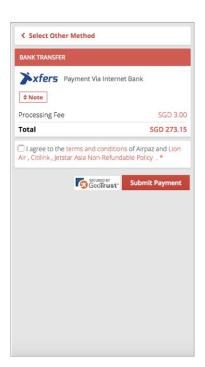
Phase 1 - Shop

Buyers shop on merchant's site and get redirected to Xfers to complete payment.

Here's an example from Airpaz, our merchant.

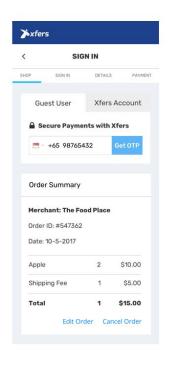


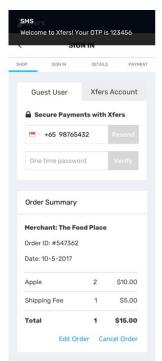


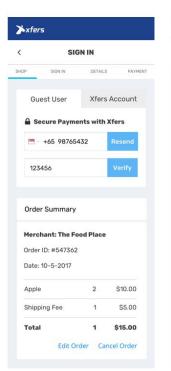


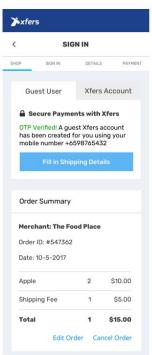
Phase 2 - Sign In As Guest

Buyers creates a guest account by entering phone number for verification



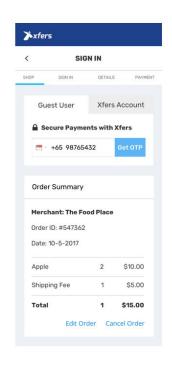


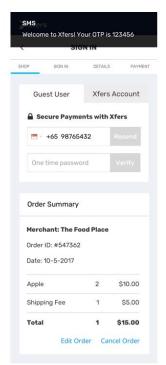


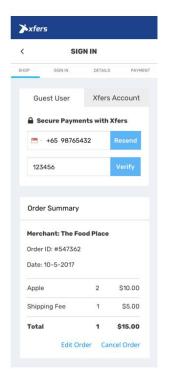


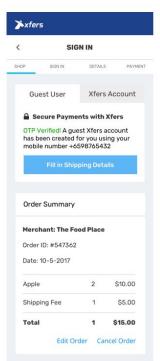
Phase 2 - Sign In With Xfers Account

Buyers login to their account using email and password. After sign in into their account balance will be displayed.





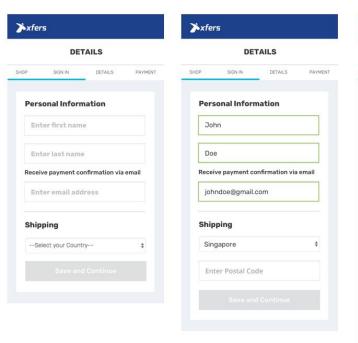


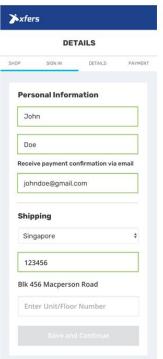


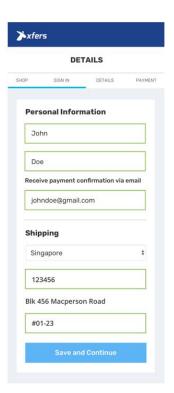
Phase 3 - Details

Buyers dislikes filling forms.

The fields are disclosed progressively to prevent buyers from feeling overwhelmed.







Phase 4 - Payment & Confirmation



Bank Transfer

Payment is not instant: Buyers leave the checkout page and perform the bank transfer in their iBanking websites. They have up to 48 hours to complete payment.

Payment Reminder: Required because payment is not instant. Sellers need to hold the order and inventory for 48 hours until buyers complete the payment.

Save Payment Method: The same unique virtual account number is assigned to each buyer for every transaction via Xfers such that there is no need to add a new payee each time.



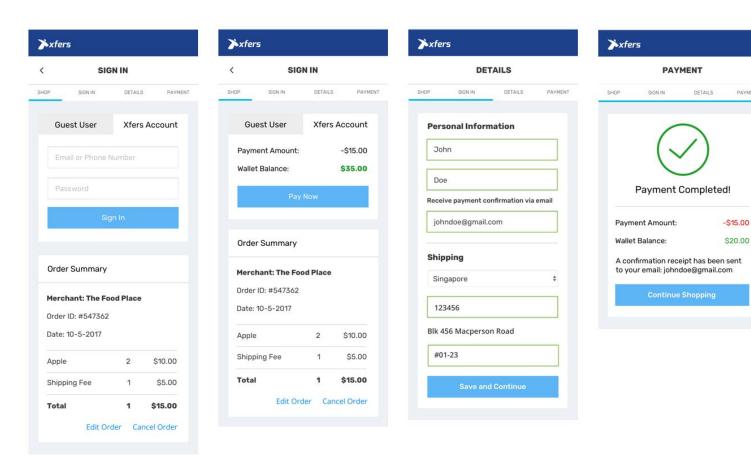
Credit Card

Payment is instant: Money is charged once the credit card information is verified.

Payment Reminder: Not required. All credit card transactions are completed instantly.

Save Payment Method: Buyers can save credit card info to remove the hassle of keying in each time.

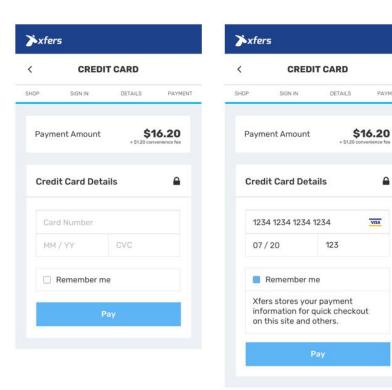
Deduct from Xfers account when there is sufficient balance.

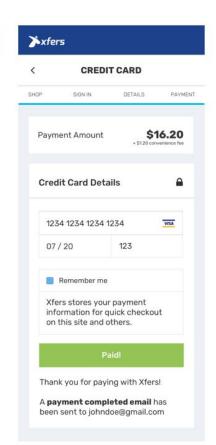


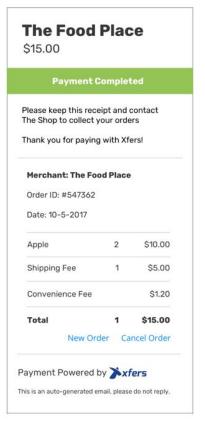
